

2012 Update to **Homeless Conditions in Gainesville** (2009)

The number of homeless people counted in Alachua County has grown substantially over the years. The table below gives a brief statistical picture of the growth through the time of our most recent 24 hour survey, on January 24-25, 2012. Our method of counting does not capture the numerous individuals and families who do not have homes of their own and currently depend on the hospitality of family and friends for nightly shelter.

Analysis of the information collected during the survey is in process and will be published here in June 2012. In the meantime, the 2009 report "Homeless Conditions in Gainesville" continues to reflect the character of homelessness in Alachua County.
